Management also reserves the right to update these Regulations and to take any measures deemed necessary.

Anyone who fails to follow these Regulations may be required by Management to leave Baia Domizia Camping Village.

Check-in



1. On arrival, Guests will be required to:

- **fill in a Public Safety form;**
- **produce a valid form of ID.**

After check-in, Guests will receive:

- **a personal pass, to be shown during any staff checks;**
- **an identification wristband, to be worn at check-in and throughout their entire stay.**

Access to the property will not be permitted to anyone who refuses to wear the identification wristband.

At check-in, Guests are also required to declare:

- **the exact number of people in the group;**
- the number of vehicles.

Any inaccuracies or changes must be reported immediately.

Village Check-In – Accommodation Units

1. **Accommodation Units are available from 5:00 pm.**
2. At check-in, a **cash security deposit** is required, as indicated in the Price List.

The deposit will be returned at departure, subject to verification of the condition of the accommodation. Within 24 hours of arrival, Guests are required to check the inventory and report any missing and/or damaged items.



Campsite Check-In – Pitches

1. Check-in for pitches is available **from 08:00 am to 10:00 pm**.
2. Each pitch may only be occupied by:
 - one caravan, motorhome or tent;
 - one awning;
 - one small outdoor kitchen unit;
 - one gazebo (maximum size 3 × 3 m).Provided that space for parking one car is kept available.
3. The assigned pitch may not be changed without prior authorisation from Management.

Unauthorised Entry



1. Access to and presence within Baia Domizia Camping Village by unauthorised persons constitutes a **violation of Public Security Regulations** and may also represent a breach of criminal law, including, for example:
 - Violation of Public Security Regulations;
 - Violation of Art. 614 of the Italian Penal Code (trespassing);
 - Violation of Art. 633 of the Italian Penal Code (unlawful occupation of land or buildings);
 - Violation of Art. 624 of the Italian Penal Code (theft of services).
2. Staff are authorised to verify the identity of anyone not wearing the identification wristband and, if the person is not properly registered, to proceed as follows:

Anyone found inside Baia Domizia Camping Village without proper registration or without a valid day visitor pass will be required to pay the applicable fee and leave the property immediately. This is without prejudice to Management's right to report the matter to the Public Security Authorities.

If a Guest allows unregistered persons to enter the property, Management may terminate the contract at its sole discretion, and require the immediate departure of the Guest and their group. In such cases, the Guest will also be required to pay the full fee for the unregistered person, calculated from the group's arrival date.

Cash Desk Hours



Every day: **8:30 am – 12:00 pm, 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm.**

Payments made outside the cash desk hours are subject to a surcharge, as indicated in the Price List.

Check-out



- I. At departure, Guests are required to:
 - **return all personal passes**, including those for vehicles;
 - **return all identification wristbands**.Returns are only allowed during cash desk hours.

Any failure to return/loss of personal passes or identification wristbands will incur a **penalty for each item**, as specified in the Price List.

Early or late departures must also take place during cash desk hours (8:30 am – 12:00 pm, 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm).

Village Check-Out – Accommodation Units

- I. **Departure must be by 10:00 am.**

At the end of their stay, Guests are required to:

- dispose of waste in the designated recycling points;
- leave the accommodation in the same condition as it was found. Otherwise, the cost of additional cleaning will be deducted from the security deposit.

Campsite Check-Out – Pitches

- I. **Departure must be by 10:00 am.**

It is mandatory to keep the pitch clean and tidy throughout the stay. If the pitch is not properly maintained, Management reserves the right to charge for cleaning costs. Guests must remove all personal belongings from the pitch at the end of their stay.



1. **Guests under 18 years of age** are not allowed inside Baia Domizia Camping Village **without a valid form of ID and unaccompanied** by their parents or another responsible adult.

The accompanying adult must sign a mandatory liability waiver covering supervision of the minor (available for download from our website).

The following documents must be attached to the waiver:

- Copy of a valid form of ID for the minor;
- Copy of a valid form of ID for the parent/legal guardian;
- Copy of a valid form of ID for the accompanying adult.

2. Accompanying adults are responsible for:

- the actions of the minors under their care;
- any damage caused by the minors to the campsite property or to other Guests, as well as any damage they themselves cause.

In any case, adults must ensure that the minors under their care do not disturb the peace or safety of other Guests at Baia Domizia Camping Village.

3. The presence of minors in the property, particularly in playgrounds and the swimming pool area, must be under the strict supervision of their accompanying adults.

Day Visitors



Day visitors are people who enter the property for the day only, **without staying overnight**.

1. Visitor access is allowed only during the periods and times specified in the current Price List.
2. Management reserves the right to limit visitor access during certain periods of the season to ensure the best quality of service for Guests already staying on site.
3. For entry, visitors must provide:
 - a **valid form of ID**;
 - for minors, a completed mandatory liability waiver.
4. Day visitors **are not allowed to bring cars or other vehicles into the property**.

Additional Guest Stays

1. Additional people may **stay overnight** at a Guest accommodation unit subject to payment of the applicable fee specified in the current Price List and respecting the maximum occupancy limits.
2. Additional Guests must check out **by 10:00 am**. Failure to do so will result in an additional day's charge, in accordance with the Price List.

Rules of Conduct

1. For the safety of Baia Domizia Camping Village and all its Guests, we recommend:
 - using only legally compliant, fireproof, properly grounded electrical cables.
2. Guests are requested to respect the peace and quiet of fellow Guests at all times, particularly between midnight and 07:00 am.
3. To ensure a pleasant and enjoyable stay for everyone, we also ask that Guests:
 - dispose of paper and waste in the designated bins;
 - wash laundry and dishes in the designated areas;
 - avoid using fountains, hydrants, or other water outlets for personal hygiene or to wash personal items;
 - use shower cabins only for the time strictly necessary;
 - leave restrooms in the best possible condition after use;
 - wash cars, motorhomes, caravans, motorcycles and other vehicles only in designated areas.
4. Management reserves the right to limit the water supply in special circumstances, including when required by the competent authorities.
5. Guests are required to follow any additional instructions provided by Management in special situations.
6. Guests are also advised to review the Harbour Authority's ordinance, available at the property, for guidance on proper conduct on the beach and at sea.

Dos and Don'ts



1. At Baia Domizia Camping Village, it is **strictly forbidden** to:
 - light fires, either inside the property or on the beach;
 - use **grills or barbecues**;
 - use electrical appliances exceeding the power allowed by the electrical columns or outlets in the accommodation units (maximum **3 KW / 13.6 A**).
 - Management is not responsible for any damage caused by voltage drops, surges, or temporary power outages;
 - use TVs, radios, or musical instruments at high volume, disturbing other Guests and the property in general;
 - dig holes, install fences or stretch ropes;
 - damage plants, trees, flower beds or lawns.

2. It is also forbidden to:
 - make any internal or external modifications to accommodation units;
 - install any type of garden furniture or equipment (gazebos, tables, chairs, swings, inflatables, children's toys, pools, etc.) either on the veranda or in the adjacent green area;
 - install decorative items of any kind (banners, decorative lights, rugs, etc.);
 - install household appliances (washing machines, dishwashers, dryers, TVs, fans, etc.) inside the unit, on the veranda, or in the adjacent green area;
 - move the perimeter boundaries of the pitches.

3. It is forbidden to organise parties, events or gatherings of any kind.

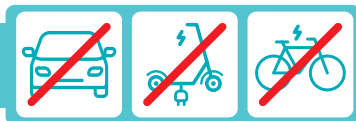
4. Guests are not allowed to let external companies or operators enter the property to provide catering, entertainment, games or animation services.

5. Separate waste collection is compulsory. Waste must be deposited in the designated recycling points. Disposal of bulky waste of any kind is strictly forbidden.

6. The Management of Baia Domizia Camping Village **accepts no liability** for damage to people or property:
 - arising from the use — at the Guest's own risk — of the facilities provided (e.g. children's playgrounds, volleyball court, basketball court, swimming pools, five-a-side football pitch, gym, fitness equipment, etc.);
 - resulting from force majeure or unforeseen events (e.g. hail, falling pine cones or branches, wind, rain, tornadoes, negligent or deliberate acts of third parties, etc.), or other circumstances beyond the control of the property's Management or staff.
7. Management is not responsible for loss, damage or theft of belongings within Baia Domizia Camping Village, even if caused by external third parties.
8. **It is strictly forbidden to bring animals of any kind or size into the property.**



Internal Traffic



Motor Vehicles

1. For the peace and safety of all Guests at Baia Domizia Camping Village, the use of motor vehicles is permitted **only for entering or exiting the property** and never for moving around within it.
Guests must observe a maximum speed limit of **10 km/h** and drive with the utmost caution, paying particular attention to all road signs.
2. **All vehicle movement is forbidden between midnight and 07:00 am.**
3. Parking any type of vehicle on the green area adjacent to the guest accommodations (bungalows, mobile homes, etc.) is strictly forbidden. This includes, for example, bicycles, mopeds, cars, etc.
4. Vehicles must only be parked in the **parking space assigned at check-in.**

Electric Vehicles

1. It is **strictly forbidden** to use the following vehicles inside Baia Domizia Camping Village:



- electric scooters;
- electric or pedal-assisted bicycles;
- electric motorcycles.

Bicycles

1. Bicycles are allowed throughout Baia Domizia Camping Village, except in clearly marked pedestrian-only areas.
2. **Bicycle use is forbidden between 8:00 pm and 07:00 am.**
3. Bicycles not parked in designated areas and left along paths, at beach access points, or near the pools may be removed by our staff and placed in the collection area.
4. Children under 12 must be accompanied or supervised by an adult.

Swimming Pool Area



1. Access to the swimming pool area is restricted to Guests wearing an **identification wristband**, in accordance with pool hours, specific regulations and the lifeguards' instructions.
2. Children under 12 may only enter the pool when accompanied by an adult.
3. Management reserves the right to close the pool in the event of bad weather, extraordinary maintenance, or hygiene concerns.
4. Before entering the pool:
 - use the footbaths provided;
 - take a shower.

5. **Swim caps are mandatory** for safety and hygiene reasons.
6. Access to the pool is permitted only in proper swimwear. Children under 4 must wear swim diapers or other containment swimwear.
7. Children under 12 are not allowed in the adult pool or whirlpool tubs.
8. Forbidden activities in the pool area:
 - Free diving in any form;
 - Diving, running, pushing others near the pools, or disturbing other Guests;
 - Use of inflatables, balls, noisy toys, masks or fins;
 - Installation and/or use of personal equipment (deck chairs, sun loungers, umbrellas, shade tents, parasols, etc.);
 - Access with carts, trolleys, air mattresses, inflatables or bulky equipment;
 - Bringing glass objects or food into the area;
 - Consuming alcoholic beverages outside designated refreshment areas.
9. Cigarette butts and waste must be disposed of in the designated bins.
10. **Sun loungers are available for an additional fee.**
11. Management or the lifeguard in charge may temporarily or permanently deny access to anyone who does not comply with the Pool Rules.

Sports Areas



1. Access to the gym is restricted to adults (18+).
Minors are not allowed, even if accompanied.
2. Use of the sports areas is **only permitted** while wearing **sports clothing and athletic shoes.**
3. For hygiene reasons, guests are required to use their own personal towel.
4. The maximum capacity of the gym is 20 people at any one time.
5. Access to the gym is forbidden in slippers or bare feet.

Definitions (glossary)

For the purposes of these Regulations, the terms used shall have the following meanings:

ACCOMMODATION / ACCOMMODATION UNIT

The lodging facility within the Village (e.g. bungalow, mobile home, glamping unit, residence) assigned to Guests for the duration of their stay.

ADDITIONAL GUEST

Person staying temporarily at a Guest accommodation unit or pitch.

ADDITIONAL GUEST STAY

Additional people may stay temporarily overnight at a regularly registered Guest accommodation unit or pitch, subject to payment of the applicable fee specified in the current Price List and respecting the maximum occupancy limits.

BAIA DOMIZIA CAMPING VILLAGE / PROPERTY

The entire tourist complex, including accommodation units, pitches, amenities, common areas, and the adjacent beach.

CHECK-IN

Registration procedure upon arrival, including delivery of personal passes and identification wristbands.

CHECK-OUT

Procedure at the end of the stay, including the return of personal passes and identification wristbands.

DAY VISITORS

People who enter Baia Domizia Camping Village without staying overnight.

DEPOSIT / SECURITY DEPOSIT

Cash amount paid as a guarantee for proper use of the accommodation unit.

GUEST

Person duly registered and authorised to stay at or access Baia Domizia Camping Village.

Definitions (glossary)

GUEST ACCOMODATION / GUEST ACCOMODATION UNIT

All the accommodation units and pitches within the property.

IDENTIFICATION WRISTBAND

A bracelet, provided at check-in, to be worn at all times during the Guest's stay, granting access to the property's services.

MANAGEMENT

The body responsible for the operation of Baia Domizia Camping Village, with the authority to apply and enforce these Regulations.

PERSONAL PASS

Document issued at check-in that identifies the Guest and must be shown to staff upon request.

PITCH

Area allocated for the use of a tent, caravan or motorhome.

RECYCLING POINTS

Designated areas for the proper disposal and separation of waste.

STAFF

Personnel authorised by Management to perform control, assistance and supervision activities within the property.

SWIMMING POOL AREA

The property's swimming pools and surrounding areas, accessible only to Guests wearing an identification wristband and subject to specific pool rules.
